MOORING INSTRUCTIONS & CONDITIONS FOR BOAT OWNERS AND START OF SEASON DELIVERY

In order to assist with the allocation, management and use of our moorings we set out below **WarrenBoats** procedures and conditions which apply for the 2024 season onwards. We very much hope this will make it easier when first arriving with your boat at the beginning of the season and help us to maintain a smooth and efficient service throughout the summer.

Once a booking has been made a mooring will be allocated which only becomes the boat owners for the season after it has been claimed by attaching a personalised marker buoy.

If your boat is being delivered by a yard or someone else please ensure they are given a copy of and follow these instructions.



We use *what3words* and will provide your unique combination of words to specifically locate your mooring. You can download the App free of charge and it is simple to use on your phone. It will give you the mooring location on a map in relation to where you currently are.

1. The mooring Zones are classified and colour coded as follows:

ZONE	COLOUR
Bluett (off Bluett Avenue)	Blue
Yacht Club (to west and slightly to east of buoyed channel)	Orange
Newells (east of channel off High St up to Northbank Hotel)	White
Halland (off old pier site)	Yellow
Seagrove (Seagrove Bay)	Yellow

Please see attached plan showing the location of these **Zones**. This plan is also on display on the Sea View Yacht Club staging.

All areas, except Seagrove, are covered by the Sea View Yacht Club Launch Service. To use this service you need to be a member of SVYC.

2. All buoys will have a numbered tag in a colour to match the Zone they are in. Boat owners will be allocated their tag number shortly before the date they have requested a mooring and must pick up this mooring. Please note tags are numbered on both sides.
3. Larger moorings, especially for yachts may not have a tag attached as the buoys are often personalised and have strops attached.

4. Moorings are available for the season from 1st May to 30th September, weather permitting. Outside of this period moorings can only be provided by special arrangement.
5. Moorings need to be booked, preferably at least 3 weeks in advance by completing our Mooring Booking Form available on the website or by request. Mooring availability, especially in the Yacht Club area, is restricted and late bookings may result in your preference not being available.
6. If the date you require a mooring changes by more than a week please let us know in advance. We wish to ensure moorings are only allocated when they are needed. We reserve the right to re-allocate moorings not taken up.
7. If you are unable to find your mooring please contact us on 01983 655123, 07867 803546 or by email. Failing that please temporarily put your boat on an **unmarked mooring** (ie one without a tag or marker buoy on it) and let us know ASAP for further instructions.
8. All moorings which have been tagged are allocated and all unmarked moorings are unallocated. **Under no circumstances should you pick up a mooring tagged with a different number or allocated to someone else. Failure to comply with this instruction may incur additional charges.**
9. **With the exception of ring buoys and larger moorings, it is important you attach your own marker buoy straight away with your name clearly written on. This claims the allocated mooring for the season** (not forgetting to remove the marker buoy at the end of the season!)
10. Please do not remove our tag from the mooring buoy. If it does come off by mistake let us know as soon as possible and we will fix it back on.
11. It is a requirement that all boats using our moorings have a minimum of third party insurance and we ask for confirmation that this is in place before the boat goes on the mooring.
12. Please note we will not be held responsible for any damage caused to boats in locations (especially Seagrove Bay) where moorings may dry out. If at any time you are concerned about the depth of water your boat is moored in, please inform **WarrenBoats** by email and you will be relocated.
13. **If you are concerned your boat is moored too close to another boat please inform WarrenBoats immediately, preferably by email, so that we can check and adjust the mooring. Please note informing the SVYC Boatman is not sufficient; you must inform us directly.**
14. In adverse weather conditions you are responsible for moving your boat from our mooring to a safe haven.
15. Moorings are provided on an exclusive basis for the boat specified and it is prohibited to sub-let, assign or share in any way with another party. You must not leave 2 boats on the same mooring and it is not advised to leave rowing dinghies on a mooring overnight.
16. Anchoring of boats within the mooring Zones is not advised and is prohibited overnight.
17. The procedure for Seaview dinghy moorings will be the same as in previous seasons. All moorings now have a yellow ring buoy. We are able to supply a temporary strop making coming alongside much easier. Let us know if you would like one fitted to your boat for a small fee.
